Tuition and Fees

Tuition and fees are based on the number of credit hours taken. Detailed information could be found online www.uakron.edu/student-accounts/costs/graduate-tuition2.dot

Estimated tuition, fees, books and student insurance for pursuing Akron Master's Program in Mechanical Engineering is about \$30,000 for two years, depending on the number of credits required.

- Taking 12 credits during the first academic year (about \$10,500/first year).
- Taking 18 or 20 credits during the second academic year (about \$17,500/second year)
- International student insurance: about \$1,100 per year
- Books (estimate): \$1,000 per year

Cost of Living:

Average living expenses for nine month \$11,220 (on campus) or \$9,370 (off campus)
