

Pre-sessional English is an intensive English language course designed to prepare you for your chosen degree programme at University of the West of Scotland.

There are two different lengths of pre-sessional English language courses: 10 weeks or five weeks. The right choice for you will depend on your current level of English.

About the course

Pre-sessional English is an intensive course taught by qualified and experienced tutors who will help you to achieve your academic goals and reach the English language level necessary to join your degree programme.

There are 21 hours of taught classes per week with four hours of directed study.

The focus of the course is to prepare you for all aspects of academic study; classes will include communicative seminars, discussion groups and presentations. Lectures and talks from outside speakers for note-taking, seminar discussion and writing practice are an integral part of the course to give you the widest possible exposure to 'real English'.

Our classes are enjoyably interactive and task-based to build your confidence when communicating in English.

The directed study agreed between you and your tutor will concentrate on specific areas of language where you feel challenged and need to improve. Independent learning is an essential part of our degree programmes and the hours of directed study will enable you to concentrate on developing this skill. You will also attend focused one-to-one tutorials to discuss your progress and identify any additional support you might need.

There are opportunities to participate in a vibrant social programme with events both on and off campus and excursions to explore the beautiful landscape and rich heritage that Scotland has to offer. This will enable you to make friends, broaden your horizons and practise your English in a more relaxed environment.

The course will introduce you to living in the UK and help you to be ready for your university studies at UWS.

In most cases, classes are small but on occasions you may be working in a larger group of up to 20 students.

Assessment

- A portfolio of evidence including assignments, presentations, homework and project work
- Your academic English development will be assessed through regular intensive English language tests
